Thanks for positive reply. I have one more suggestion for improvement.

Currently when the module and compoent lists the available links or category, they does not consider user access level. For example, I set some category to be "registered" only, but they still appear on the category list for anonymous users. This is the same for the links on the calenda.

Though the users may actually denied access due to Joomla's access control, it is still better to hide the access, from my point of view.

So far so good. The module and componuents work well with SEF (amazingly). and i prefer waiting for your next release and giving a good rank at joomla extensiion site.

Actually Joomblog uses Joomla itself to manage contents, i.e. items are listed based on joomla section. If mamblog is not installed on your site, it will be automatically disabled for Mamblog. In case Mamblog is installed and there is no section configured in BlogSidebar Admin Panel, then Mamblog will be enabled.

Now if you want to use mod\_blogsidebar for Joomblog, you can simply configure joomblog sections by using Admin Back Panel.

Actually, there are two sets of information in category links

- Itemid (Indiacates top level menu item associated within Joomla!)
- Category ID

Both are used by Joomla Core to display contents. Category ID should be correct anyway so we should look at itemID... Can you check ItemID for both the sections and see if it is correctly associated? If it is correct, you have to modify section information. (It may be not correct, why? look below)

1. Joomla will pick title/name and section based on Itemid. Section name or title may be incorrect (please double check in section manager!)
2. Check Menu Items (Check for correct name in the menu associated with Itemid)

Let me know.
